PROTECTIVE MEASURES AGAINST COVID-19

In accordance with the health emergency declared by the Ministry of Health, on account of Coronavirus (Covid-19), the following instructions have been prepared for Competency Assessment applicants for the different certificates who enter the premises of CIMAR.

1	Reception of applicants will be in a room at the entrance of the complex for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Registration and signing of a sworn statement of absence of COVID-19 symptoms. – Temperature check. – Information on prevention and control on CIMAR premises. – Provision of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).
2	In case the applicant does not agree with the measures to be adopted, he/she should leave the premises, previously signing a document stating his/her decision.
3	The complex has detailed and concise information on the regulations and recommendations regarding physical contact, distancing and hygiene.
4	Displacement is only from the room at the entrance of the complex to CIMAR premises, where there are permanent sanitary measures for every person in indoor areas with their corresponding PEE.
5	Monitoring of established regulations in the examination or simulation rooms in order to execute the competency assessments according to the instructions under (1).
6	A maximum number of applicants in a classroom or simulator is established, having into account the characteristics of the place.
7	These areas will be disinfected and the time applicants are in the classroom and simulator will be controlled for sanitary breaks and air circulation.
8	The toilets for applicants' use are on the first floor of the simulator building, under established hygiene measures. There will be constant cleaning and disinfection of toilets.
9	There must be strict hand hygiene during the whole examination process.
10	The final cleaning and waste management will be at the end of the day in the room at the entrance of the complex.
